Subj: MARINE CORPS JUNIOR RESERVE OFFICERS TRAINING CORPS
(MCJROTC) ORIENTATION VISITS

Ref: (a) MCO P1533.6D

1. Purpose. To publish information and assign responsibilities for subject visits.
2. Cancellation. ABO 1533.1D
3. Background. Annually, certain Marine Corps Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (MCJROTC) units request and participate in orientation visits to major Marine Corps installations as set forth by reference (a). The primary purpose of the orientation visit is to provide the cadets with a glimpse of Marine Corps life. An adequate training schedule is imperative to maximize the positive influence of the orientation visit on the individual cadet's attitude toward the Marine Corps.
4. Action. To support the subject visits the following actions are assigned:
 - a. Director, Joint Public Affairs Office
 - (1) Coordinate all aspects of subject visits to include the development of schedules.
 - (2) Provide a Command Project Officer.
 - (3) Provide appropriate press coverage.
 - (4) Coordinate escort personnel as required.
 - (5) Provide a welcome aboard package to include appropriate command information material.

b. AC/S, Marine Corps Community Service (MCCS)

(1) Provide Exchange privileges as set forth by Navy Exchange Manual.

(2) Provide MCCS assistance to the visiting liaison officer, as well as discount coupons and access for the cadets to appropriate MCCS facilities.

c. AC/S, G-3

(1) Provide briefings and tours of airfield operations facilities upon request.

(2) Provide audiovisual support as required. Provide flight simulation tours as requested that will not interfere with scheduled training.

d. AC/S, G-4

(1) Provide messing and billeting for MCJROTC chaperons and male and female cadets, as required.

(2) Provide ground transportation support as required.

e. Director, Branch Medical Clinic

(1) Provide medical treatment of an emergency or humanitarian nature to cadets on orientation visits as required.

(2) Provide briefings and tours of the Aviation Physiology Training facility upon request.

f. Commanding General, 3d Marine Aircraft Wing (3d MAW)

(1) Designate a project officer to coordinate 3d MAW requirements.

(2) Provide static display aircraft as required.

(3) Provide tours of working areas upon request.

(4) Provide fixed wing and helicopter orientation support upon request, that will not interfere with normal operations.

(5) Provide escort officers in conjunction with tours of 3d MAW working areas and/or aircraft.

5. Concurrence. The Commanding General, 3d Marine Aircraft Wing and Commanding Officer, Marine Air Group 46 concur in the provisions of this order.
