Subj: MARINE CORPS AIR STATION (MCAS) MIRAMAR, MARINE CORPS
COMMUNITY SERVICES (MCCS) GOLF ADVISORY COMMITTEE

1. Purpose. To set forth the composition and duties of the MCAS Miramar MCCS Golf Advisory Committee. The purpose of the Golf Advisory Committee is to consider suggestions concerning the improvement of the course and forward approved recommendations to the Chief of Staff via the Assistant Chief of Staff, MCCS for review.

2. Cancellation. StaO 1710.2.

3. Membership

a. It is emphasized that only willing, interested and capable personnel should be nominated. Individuals must be acquainted with the United States Golf Association (USGA) and local rules of Golf.

b. The Golf Advisory Committee will be comprised of the following:

(1) Chairman. The senior active duty officer (field grade) will be designated by the Committee as the Committee Chairman unless otherwise appointed by the Chief of Staff.

(2) One field grade officer or senior staff non-commissioned officer will be appointed as voting members from:

(a) Commanding Officer, Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron (HQHQRON).

(b) Commanding General, 3d Marine Aircraft Wing (3d MAW).

(c) President, Miramar Memorial Men's Golf Club.

(d) President, Miramar Memorial Women's Golf Club.

(3) Length of appointment will be for two (2) years effective the beginning of the calendar year.

(4) The MCCA Business Operations Director or designated representative, Head Golf Pro and Golf Course Superintendent will serve as non-voting members. These members will attend meetings of the Golf Advisory Committee and will act in an advisory capacity for the implementation of recommendations.

4. Meetings. Meetings will be held quarterly at times and locations designated by the Chairman. Minutes of the meeting will be signed by the Chairman and forwarded to the Chief of Staff via the Assistant Chief of Staff, MCCA.

5. Action. The Golf Course Advisory Committee will:

a. Act only in an advisory capacity and will not, as a group or individual, engage in any management or operation function.

b. Receive no remuneration from MCCA in cash, goods or services for any functions performed as a group, or as an individual, during or after working hours.

c. Submit recommendations for major improvements or modifications to the golf course.

d. Submit recommendations for slow play, playing conditions, etiquette and utilization of course tournaments.

e. Ensure rules and regulations are adhered to and promoted.

6. Certification. Reviewed and approved this date.
